



Board Member Vacancy Notice

The Select Board are currently accepting applications for one vacancy on the Natick Housing Authority. The Natick Housing Authority (NHA) is a public body, politic and corporate, established under Massachusetts General Laws Chapter 121B whose primary mission is to provide decent, safe and sanitary housing opportunities, thereby improving the quality of life for those of low income, including families, those with disabilities and elders. The 5-member Natick Housing Authority Board oversees the authority's overall direction. Board Members approve all significant contract awards, make budget decisions, and send formal submissions to State and Federal agencies. They also make all major policy decisions and deal with many other important authority matters. The Natick Housing Authority is committed to full compliance with all local, state and federal nondiscrimination laws, the Americans with Disabilities Act; and U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development regulations governing Fair and Equal Housing Opportunity. Members shall possess the skills and experience which can contribute to the purpose and mission of the NHA. The Panel shall have a diversity of exposure and interests so as to reflect the broad interests of the Natick community. No Panel member shall represent any particular group or special interests except only the broad interests of the Natick community.
